

#### Student Health, COVID, Medication

**STUDENT HEALTH**: If your child is not well enough to fully participate in the school day, please keep them home. Please note that children must stay home if they have a fever and must be fever free for 24 hours *WITHOUT* fever reducing medication before returning to school. If a child becomes ill while at school, a parent will be called to to pick up.



<u>COVID</u>: Per CDC and VDH Guidance, COVID vaccination Is encouraged but not required for students and employees as a measure of a protection. During times of HIGH community level per CDC guidelines, masks are optional but strongly recommended. Please contact LaToya Good in the front office and your child's teacher as soon as possible if your child tests positive. Positive individuals must isolate and remain out of school for 5 days. OK to return on day 6 as long as fever free. Please mask indoors on days 6-10.

**MEDICATION**: If your child needs to receive prescription or over the counter medication while at school due to allergies or other health concerns, please inform LaToya Good in the front office so that the proper medication consent forms can be completed. Do not send medication in your child's lunchbox or backpack. This includes over the counter pain relievers and supplements.

#### **Absences and Tardies**

Our school program is created to promote a rhythm that allows learning to unfold in a balanced way. Regular, timely attendance allows students to fully experience the curriculum.



**ABSENCES**: If your child will be absent, please inform the school as soon as possible. Leave a message on the attendance line by dialing 804-377-8024 and selecting option 1 or by sending an email to LaToya Good at Igood@richmondwaldorf.com. Consistent attendance supports healthy rhythms and supports the educational journey for children. See the Family Handbook for more information.

**TARDIES**: Any student arriving after 8:15 a.m. must be signed in by an authorized caregiver at the Main Entrance. If a student will be absent or tardy beyond 8:30 a.m. the parent or guardian should call the school office by 8:15 a.m. The Attendance Line can be reached by dialing the main number, 804-377-8024 and dialing option 1.




